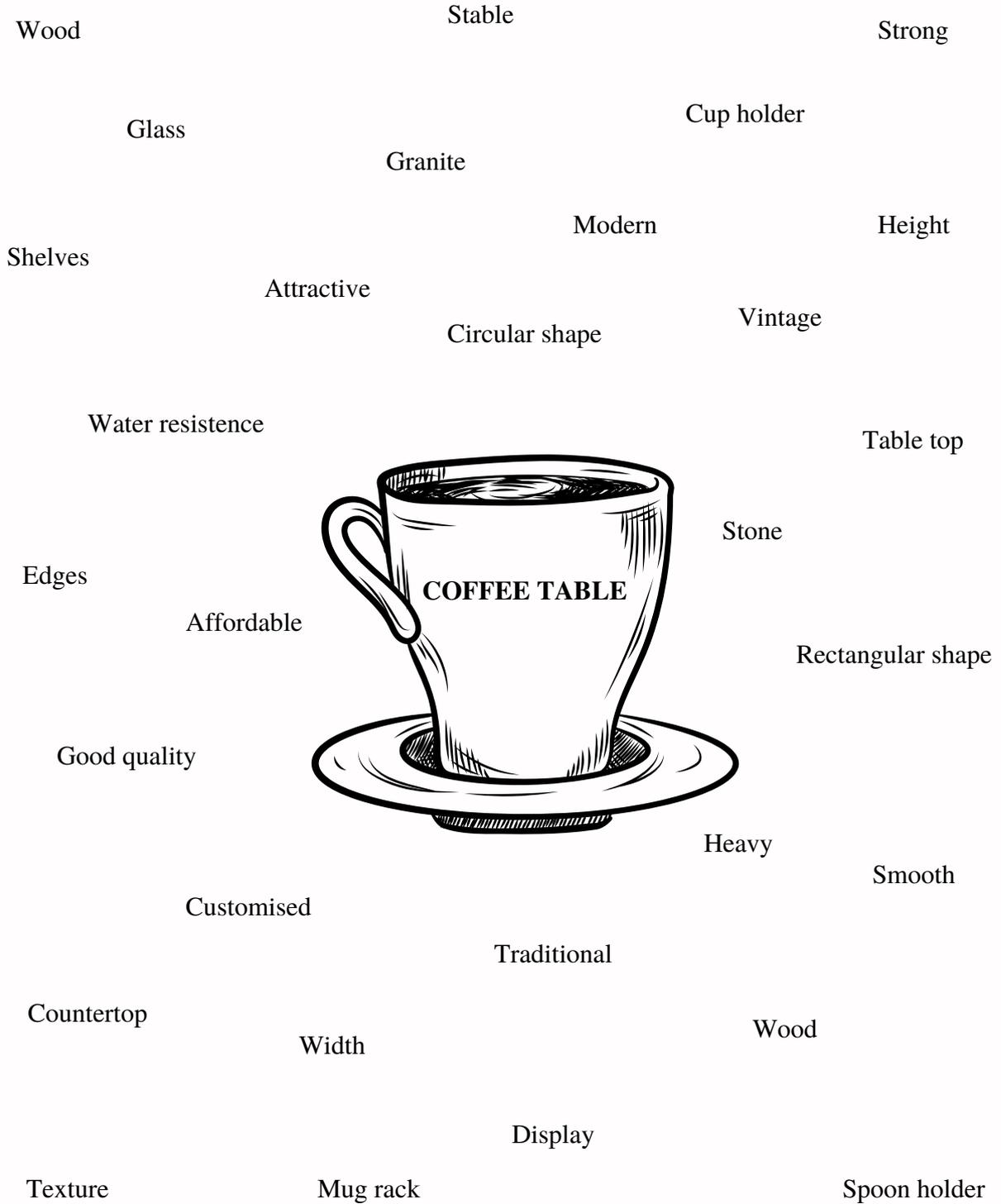

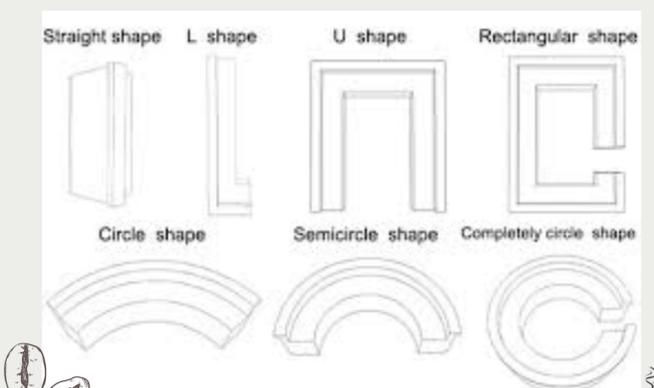

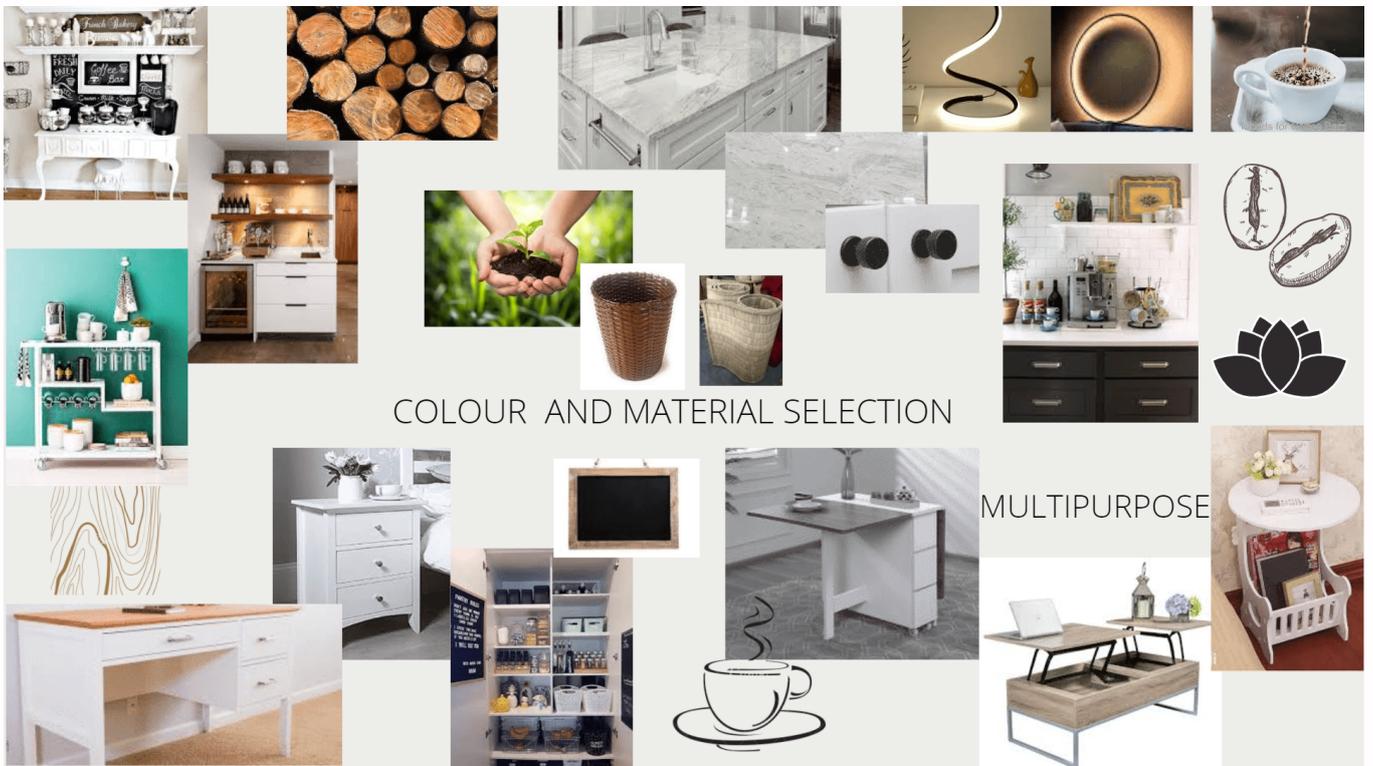

### Seat Height vs Counter Height

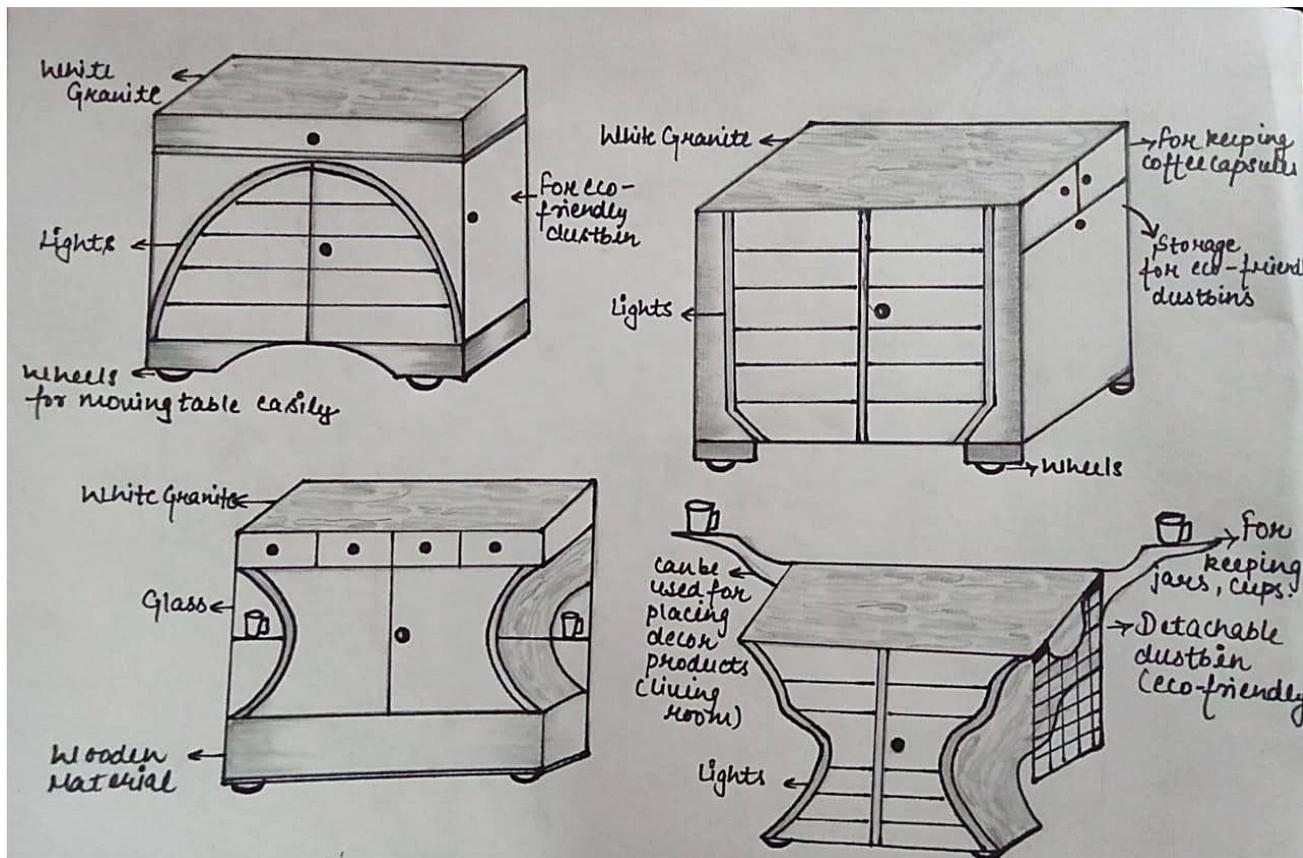

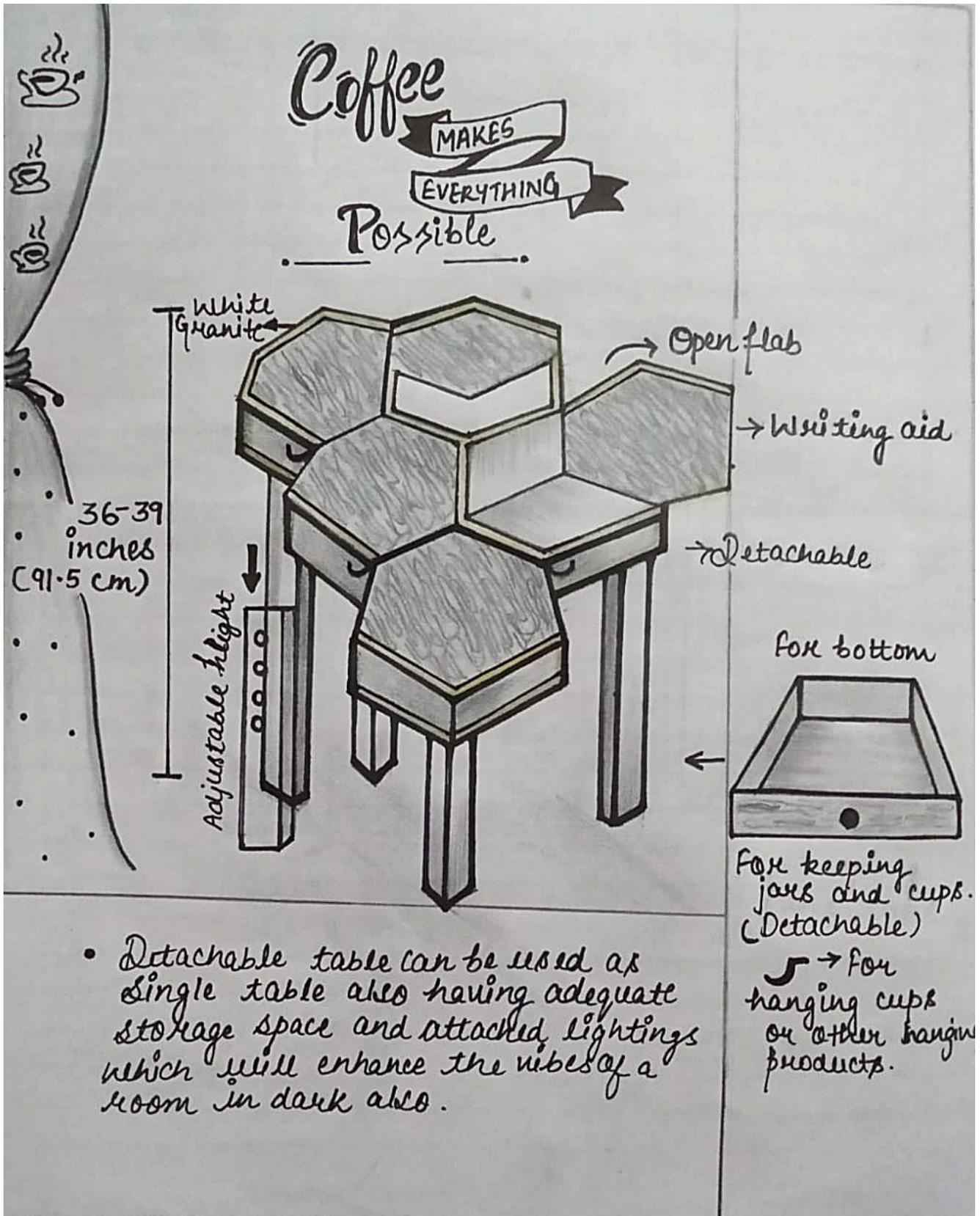
